RE: School Code 1937261 – Re-Approval Application

On October 11, 2009, Governor Schwarzenegger signed Assembly Bill (AB) 48 (Portantino, Chapter 310, Statutes of 2009.) AB 48 is known as the Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 ("Act"). The Act establishes the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education ("Bureau") within the Department of Consumer Affairs. The Act became operative on January 1, 2010. The text of the Act is available online at www.bppe.ca.gov.

Our records indicate your institution submitted an application for re-approval prior to the sunset of the Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education Reform Act. Section 94802(b)(1) of the Act requires that applications for reapproval received by the former Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education prior to January 1, 2006 shall be deemed approved and the institution shall be granted an approval to operate until 2012 to coincide with the anniversary date of the current approval to operate. Section 94802(b)(2) of the Act requires that applications for reapproval received after January 1, 2006 shall be deemed approved and the institution shall be granted an approval to operate until 2013 to coincide with the anniversary date of the current approval to operate.

Based upon Section 94802(b)(1),(2) of the Act, the approval to operate for your school is valid until April 7, 2013. Please use this document as official notice of the expiration date of your approval to operate as of January 1, 2010.

Section 94802(c) of the Act requires institutions, operating under the terms of section 94802(b)(1) or section 94801(b)(2) of the Act, notify a student seeking to enroll of the status of the institution's pending application. The Bureau recommends the following language for the required notice: "Although this institution was approved to operate by the former Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education, our pending application for reapproval to operate has not yet been reviewed by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education."

To ensure that the Bureau has the most current information regarding your institution we are requesting you complete the enclosed Institution Information Update form and return it to the Bureau by February 1, 2010.
